#### **Directions**

Please find attached a map showing the location of Middle Harbour Yacht Club. We recommend that all guests park in the large car park opposite the club. Please do not park at Middle Harbour Yacht Club.

#### **Programme**

A programme of the day's sailing event is attached. Unfortunately, guests who are late and arrive after their boat has 'set sail' (approx. 12.40pm) may miss out on the sailing component of the event.

#### **Prizes**

#### **Dress Code**

We suggest guests dress for comfort and wear closed in shoes with white, non marking soles. A good fitting cap, sunglasses, a wind sheeter / raincoat (if necessary) and sunscreen are also recommended.

#### **Branding of your Yacht**

In order to foster team spirit, teams are encouraged to dress in branded company apparel (t-shirts, windcheaters and/or caps). Most skippers are happy to display signage in the form of 1 or 2 banners tied on the handrails – approximate size is 2m x 1m. This may be well labelled and couriered to MHYC prior to the event or brought with you on the day.

#### **Wet Weather**

The event will go ahead, rain, hail or shine. The sailing element of the day will be managed by MHYC. The race manager reserves the authority to modify or cancel the race should they deem the conditions unsafe.

#### **Safety**

All yachts have submitted a "Yachting Australia Special Regulations Equipment Compliance Certificate" (or equivalent) and come with statutory safety equipment. Please do not hesitate to request a life jacket should you wish to wear one. Whilst the course will be held within the confines of the Harbour, the yachts will heel and ride over seas. We ask that your crew are aware of typical sailing conditions.

The post-race bbq is included for all registered sailing guests. Additional tickets are available for partners or colleagues via the website for only \$120pp or contact David Trayner.

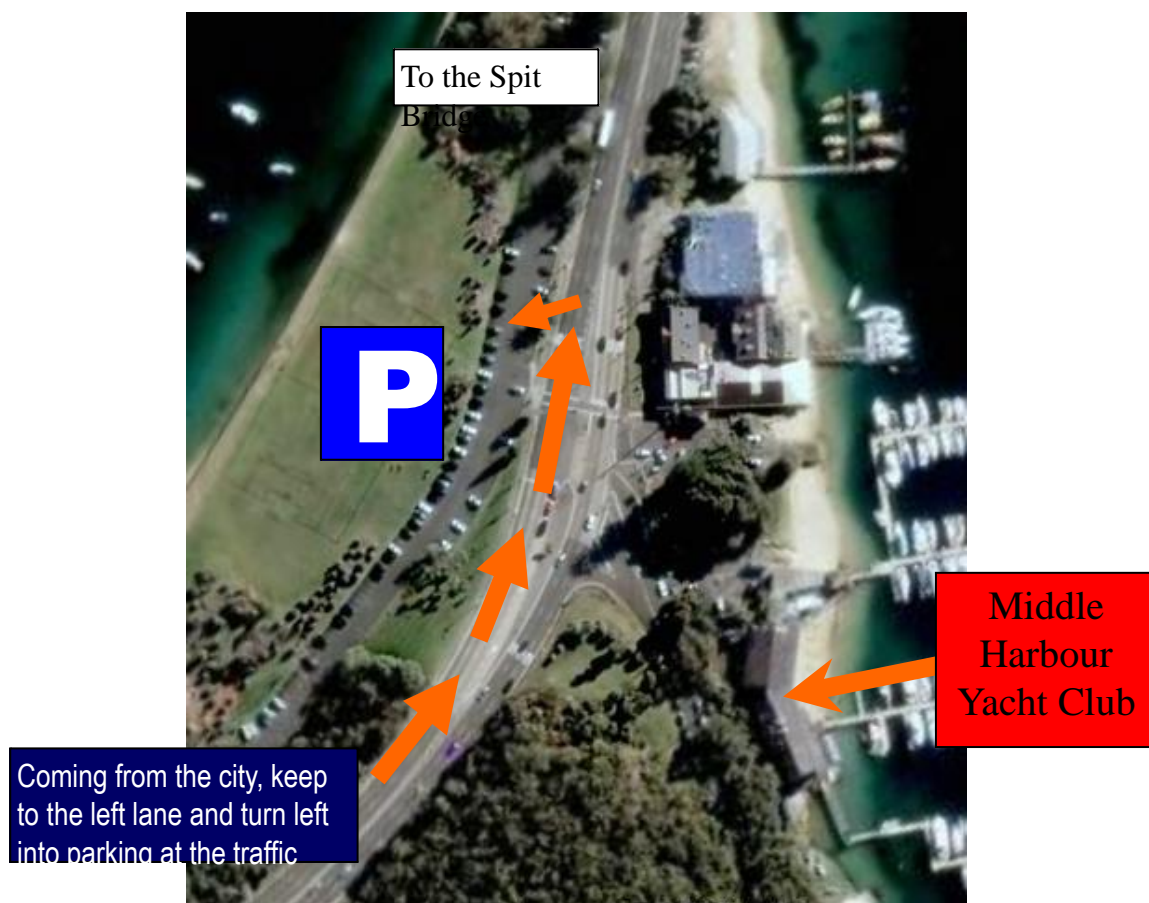
#### **Beneficiary**
